

STUDENT DRIVER GUIDELINES

- ***Driving a motor vehicle carries with it serious legal and social responsibilities, especially within our school environment where staff, students, families and community members access the school parking areas.***
- ***It is a privilege, not a right for students to access parking bays at Denmark Senior High School.***
- ***The Guidelines below outline the requirements for student drivers, their parent/carers and passengers.***
- Any student of legal driving age who intends to drive to school, either on a regular basis or occasionally, must comply with the *Student Driver Guidelines*.
- Students need to obtain a permit to park at the school. This application is available from the front office.
- The parking permit, granted upon successful application to park at the school, should be displayed on the driver's side dashboard of the vehicle whilst it is on school grounds.
- Students are to park in the designated student parking bays only.
- Students are not permitted under any circumstances to drive from the school grounds during the school day without written permission.
- Students are required to enter and leave the carpark with care and responsibility ensuring they are following the road rules.
- Students are not permitted to go to their vehicle during the school day. The school carpark is out of bounds from 8:50am – 3:15pm each day.
- If breaches of any of the above guidelines are reported, the matter will be referred to the Deputy Principal or Principal. This may result in the Parking Permit being withdrawn and parents being notified. This will mean that a student is placed on Provisional Standing. Serious breaches may lead to suspension of the student from school.
